It costs \$200 a year or approximately \$16 a month for one back pack. So see Bryan or write on a communication card if you want to help out. Thanks again!

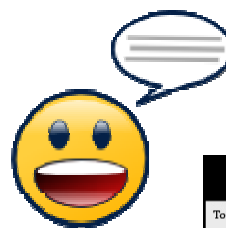

We hope your time with us is meaningful and enjoyable. To help you feel comfortable, here are some things we will be doing today along with a brief explanation of why we do them.

Singing

Throughout the service we sing because it gives us the opportunity to express our love and appreciation to Jesus Christ and to God. The words help us focus on who He is, what He has done for us and why we are here on earth.

Psalm 96

Reading and Prayer

We read a Bible passage that will help us focus on what Christ has done for us and what He means to us. Then we take a moment to express our dependence on and appreciation for the love God offers us.

Ephesians 6:17-18

The Lord's Supper

In an act of remembering Jesus' sacrifice and love for us, we celebrate the Lord's Supper. We pass trays with a piece of bread and a cup of juice. If you have accepted Jesus Christ as your personal Lord and Savior, we invite you to take a piece of bread, eat it, take a cup of juice, drink it and pass the tray.

Moment of Friendship

We take a little time when we are together to greet one another. This provides us an opportunity to meet and welcome new people as well as share a smile with old friends.

Message

Every week a different message is presented, often part of a series of messages. This is our time to learn from the Bible how God loves us and His expectations of us.

Invitation

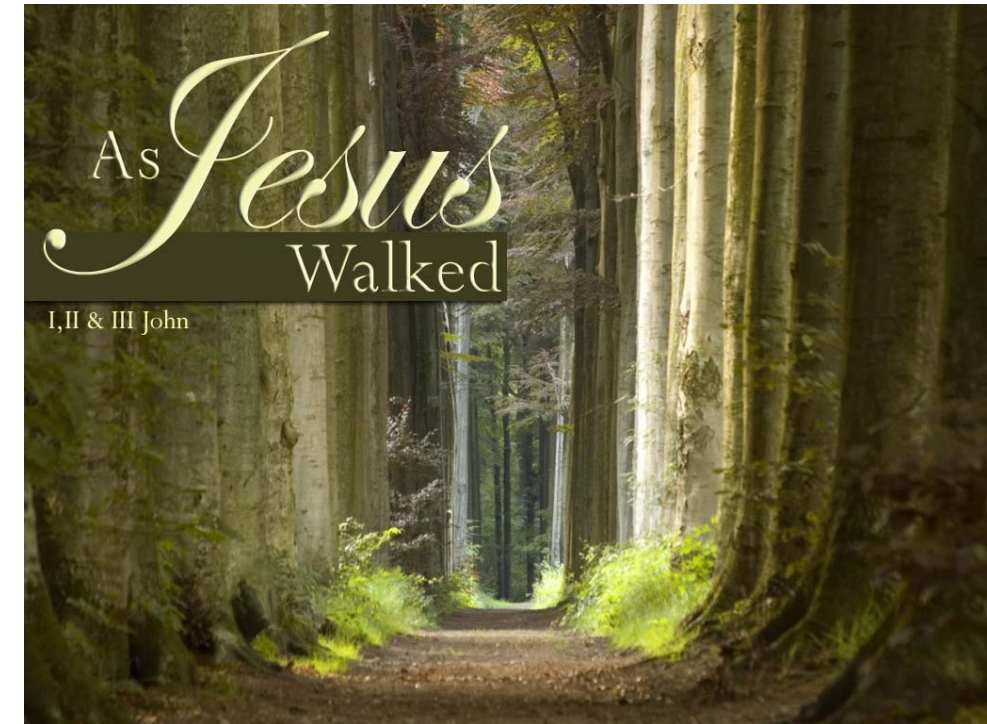
