Your \$50 deposit is due ASAP. All forms & final payments are due by Sunday, May 16.

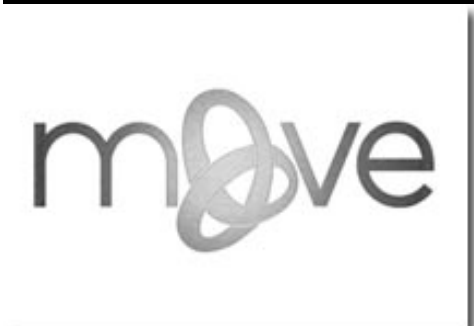

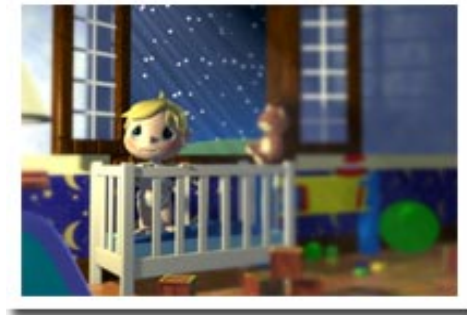
EASTER LILIES

ESTATE PLANNING SEMINAR

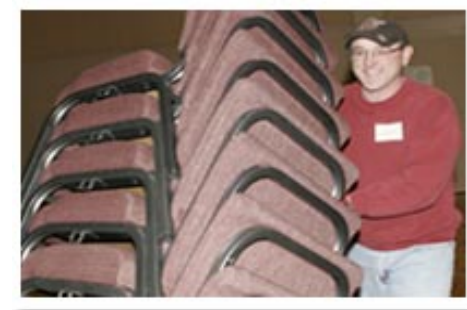

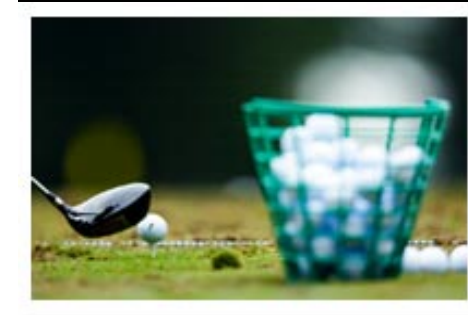
CHAIR SETTERS
