Reading and Prayer

We read a Bible passage that will help us focus on what Christ has done for us and what He means to us. Then we take a moment to express our dependence on and appreciation for the love God offers us.

The Lord's Supper

In an act of remembering Jesus' sacrifice and love for us, we celebrate the Lord's Supper. We pass trays with a piece of bread and a cup of juice. If you have accepted Jesus Christ as your personal Lord and Savior, we invite you to take a piece of bread, eat it, take a cup of juice, drink it and pass the tray.

Moment of Friendship

We take a little time when we are together to greet one another. This provides us an opportunity to meet and welcome new people as well as share a smile with old friends.

Message

Every week a different message is presented, often part of a series of messages. This is our time to learn from the Bible how God loves us and His expectations of us.

Isaiah 61:1-3

Invitation

We come together with an expectation that God will speak to us, individually and to the entire group. During this time, you are invited to publicly demonstrate your response to God's involvement in your life by coming to the front when invited.

Offering

If you are a visitor, we don't expect you to give of your finances to the church. Our offering is intended to support the work of God in and through our church. It is an opportunity for those that are teamed together with us to financially support the work of this local church.

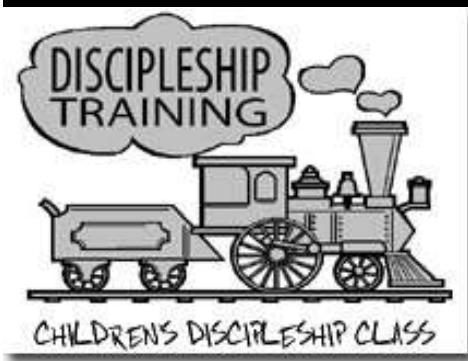
COOKING ANGELS NEEDED

DISCIPLESHIP CLASS

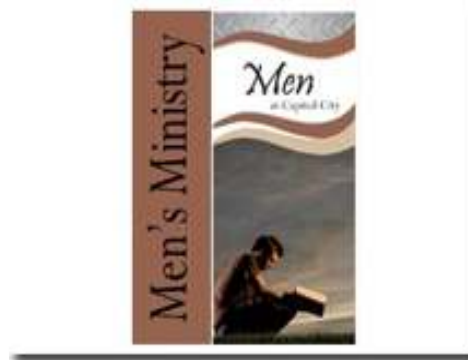


Grades 3-5
